The **Mossberg 590 Retrograde** combines proven mechanics with a refined vintage aesthetic, designed for shooting ranges.

- **caliber:** 12/76
- **Barrel length:** 51 cm (20 inches)
- **choke:** fixed cylinder
- **Sighting devices:** barleycorn
- **Stock and handguard:** walnut (retro finish)
- **Heat deflector** above the barrel

Cylinder choke

The **cylinder choke** is a barrel profile that produces a wide and even shot pattern. In practical terms, it promotes a more open dispersion of projectiles—useful for dynamic shooting exercises and target practice where a uniform shot pattern is desired.

Tubular charger

The **tubular magazine** houses the cartridges under the barrel and allows for simple and reliable feeding of the bolt. Its practical advantage: a large capacity without complex modifications to the sight line or the gripping mechanisms.

Heat deflector

The **heat deflector** is a part placed along the barrel that limits mirage effects due to heat by directing airflow.

Walnut stock

Walnut is a dense and stable wood, often chosen for its feel and aesthetics. It offers natural ergonomics—absorbing vibrations and providing an instinctive hand position—while maintaining a refined appearance over time.

In practice, these elements combine to offer a weapon that "breathes" tradition while remaining suitable for repeated sessions at the shooting range: maneuverability, accessible maintenance and constant sensations.

- **Compatible ammunition:** 12/70 and 12/76
- **Regulatory use:** Category B — use strictly reserved for sport shooting authorized in France
- **Projectile compatibility:** tested for steel shot and lead-free cartridges according to manufacturer specifications

FAQ

- **What is the length of the barrel?** The barrel measures 51 cm (20 inches).
- **Which cartridges should I use?** The rifle accepts 12/70 and 12/76 (Magnum) cartridges; always follow the manufacturer's recommendations.
- **Can it be used at a shooting range?** Yes — it is designed and suitable for sport shooting. It belongs to category B and requires the necessary prefectoral authorizations for its purchase and use in France.
