The **CHIAPPA Black Thunder 7.5" 44RM Revolver** combines the traditional mechanics of **Single Action** with a long 7.5" barrel, optimized for **sport shooting** in **.44 Remington Magnum**.

With its 7.5" barrel, this version offers a longer sight radius and improved control at the start of the shot. In **.44 Remington Magnum**, this translates to increased stability and a more complete exploitation of the caliber's ballistic performance. On target, consistency is excellent, especially at medium range.

Traditional Single Action Mechanical

The **single-action** mechanism requires manual cocking of the hammer before each shot. This system provides a crisp, clean trigger pull, appreciated for precision shooting. It's a simple, robust, and proven mechanism that appeals to those who prefer classic shooting techniques.

Modern fiber optic sight

The fixed **fiber optic** front sight and the adjustable rear sight with green insert for elevation and windage facilitate target acquisition. This system allows for fine-tuning the point of impact according to the ammunition used, a real advantage for demanding sport shooting.

Steel construction and enhanced safety

Made entirely of **steel**, the Black Thunder 7.5" is built to last. **Hogue® rubber** grips provide a firm and comfortable hold, even with dynamic loads. The **transfer bar** system enhances mechanical safety by preventing direct contact between the hammer and the firing pin without trigger action.

FAQ

What are the acquisition conditions?

This .44 Magnum caliber revolver is classified in category B. Its acquisition requires a valid prefectural authorization, a valid sports shooting license and compliance with French regulations.

What is the advantage of a 7.5" barrel?

A longer barrel provides an extended sight radius and contributes to improved shooting stability. It also allows for more effective exploitation of the .44 Remington Magnum's ballistic potential in target shooting.

Is the Transfer Bar system secure?

Yes, the transfer bar prevents the dog from striking the firing pin without pressure on the trigger, thus enhancing safety during handling and compliant transport.
