The openwork design reduces moving mass while maintaining adequate rigidity. In use, this promotes more responsive kinematics and smoother operation.

Rectified engagement surface

The trigger contact area is carefully machined to ensure consistent contact. This finishing work contributes to a crisper and more consistent trigger pull, provided the assembly is carried out by a qualified professional.

Hammer strut pinned

The assembly comes with a hammer strut mounted and pinned, facilitating integration as part of a replacement or careful preparation.

FAQ

Is this set compatible with all 1911 models?

It is designed for standard-dimension 1911 type platforms. A compatibility check by a gunsmith is recommended before installation.

Should a professional be hired for the installation?

Yes, the installation of internal components of the mechanism must be carried out by a qualified professional to ensure safety and proper functioning.
