The **KJI K700** is a versatile **shooting tripod** designed to offer maximum stability for **sport shooting**, **long-range shooting**, and tactical observation. Its anodized aluminum construction combines robustness, mobility, and a high load capacity to effectively support shooters in all terrains.

Weighing only 1.77 kg and with a compact folded size of 51 cm, it can be easily carried in a bag or attached to shooting equipment. Once deployed, the overall rigidity is immediately apparent, even with heavy setups.

Stability designed for long-range shooting

Capable of supporting up to 68 kg, this **tactical tripod** easily accommodates a precision rifle equipped with a scope, suppressor, thermal optics, or advanced aiming accessories. This high load capacity minimizes unwanted vibrations and improves shot consistency, especially during **long-range shooting** sessions or extended observation periods.

Quickly adapts to all terrains

The four-section legs feature three locking angles - 23°, 55°, and 83° - allowing for quick transitions from a standing to a lying position. On uneven terrain, slopes, or unstable ground, each leg can be adjusted independently to maintain a stable and fully usable platform.

Robust and smooth CNC Twist-Lock

The CNC-machined aluminum locking rings ensure quick and secure deployment. Even after repeated handling or under heavy load, the lock remains firm and precise. This type of locking mechanism is particularly valued in tactical configurations where rapid deployment is crucial.

Designed for harsh environments

The hard-anodized aluminum body is highly resistant to moisture, abrasion, and demanding outdoor conditions. Interchangeable legs allow the tripod to be adapted to various surfaces: gravel, mud, compacted soil, or concrete slabs. Rubber feet provide a discreet look, while metal spikes improve stability on soft ground.

Full compatibility with the KJI ecosystem

The K700 is compatible with **KJI's Reaper Grip** and **Reaper Rail** systems, as well as the brand's various Ball Heads. This modularity allows for the construction of a shooting platform perfectly suited to the shooter's needs, whether for **tactical shooting**, PRS competition, or long-range observation.
